The Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD) in cooperation with its partners and international organisations is organising the Asian Media Summit (AMS) 2006 for the third consecutive year in Malaysia from 29 until 31 May at Nikko Hotel in Kuala Lumpur.

The two-day conference will provide a unique opportunity for broadcasters in the region to share their thoughts and exchange ideas on broadcasting and information.

Some 400 decision makers, media professionals, scholars and stakeholders of news and programming from Asia, Pacific, Africa, Europe, Middle East and North America are attending this annual conference.
