BACKGROUND:

1) Malaysia International Space Adventure (MISA)

The exhibition runs from 15 December 2007 to 16 March 2008. Covering over 300,000 sq ft of exposition area, this is the first ever aerospace exhibition being held in the country. Real NASA space exploration exhibits were shipped from Europe and the USA for this exhibition.

There are eight major exhibition zones specially designed to provide visitors with a multi-dimensional and a multi-sensory experience. The major attractions are the Space Shuttle Flight Deck and the Space Station Interactive where visitors can experiment with six module racks that allow them to control and participate in everything from choreographing a spacewalk to a repair of a solar array. Another unique attraction is Malaysia's first ever spectacular 4D theatre which will enhance the overall space journey through MISA.

2) Putrajaya

Dubbed as Malaysia's first "Intelligent Garden City", Putrajaya, the Federal Government's administrative centre, is the forerunner of the future Malaysian city in the new millennium. This model city serves as the nerve of the nation and provides an ideal environment to live, work, conduct business and enjoy sports and recreational activities.

Putrajaya is located 25km from Kuala Lumpur and 20km from the modern Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) – the main gateway into the country. Getting

to the city is convenient as it is well served with a comprehensive network of public transportation comprising taxi, bus as well as rapid transit services and linked to major road and railway networks.
